

2020 Davis Cup – Asia/Oceania Regional Group IV **Eligibility & Selection Criteria**

Any player who meets the following criteria will receive an invite in due cause:

- Open to **Singapore Citizens** only.
- Player must be in good standing with SportSG & Singapore Tennis Association (STA)
- For **Males** only.
- 4 spots available.
- Age Eligibility:
 1. Only Players who have reached their fourteenth birthday by the first day of the competition (Week Commencing 8 June 2020).
- Invitation **without trial** for available spots on the Team:
 1. National Squad Players with ATP Singles Ranking.
 2. National Squad Players ranked in the top 600 of the ATP Doubles Ranking.
 3. Non-National Squad Players with ATP Singles Ranking or is ranked in the top 600 of the ATP Doubles Ranking may write to the Selection & Preparation Panel for consideration for a spot on the representing team.
- Invitation to **selection trial** for the **remaining spots** on the team in due cause:
 1. National Squad Player without ATP Singles or Doubles Ranking or is ranked outside the top 600 of the ATP Doubles Ranking at the point of the selection exercise will go into the selection trials.
 2. Non-National Squad Player who meets the following criteria at the point of the selection exercise and have indicated their interest in writing to Selection & Preparation Panel for a spot in the selection trials:
 - i. Ranked outside the top 600 of the ATP Doubles Ranking.
 - ii. Ranked in the top 2,200 of the ITF World Tennis Tour Singles or Doubles Ranking.
 - iii. Ranked in the top 600 of the ITF Junior Ranking.
 - iv. Men ranked in the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Division 1 Singles Ranking list.
 - v. A pre-trial may be conducted for a spot in the selection trials at the Selection and Preparation Panel's discretion in the event that there is an overwhelming interest.
 - vi. Other suitable players based on the Panel's discretion.

***Only ATP Rankings from 1st January 2020 will be taken into consideration.**

*Davis Cup 2020 and 2021 will be used to build the players' performance profile for benchmarking for SEA Games 2021. The association will engage the players who participate in them and also track their commitment and performance to ensure that they go on to represent Singapore at SEA Games 2021.
